4. In Genesis 46:31-34, why did the Egyptians despise the Hebrews? Was it race or occupation? You can also look at Genesis 43:32 and Exodus 8:22 for other examples.
6. Is there something in your life right now that seems backwards or inefficient? What can you learn about God and your response to God through this?
